



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
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Long-Term Residential settings are homes or apartments where residents require 24-hour support for safety and/ or assistance. Intermittent assistance provided throughout a typical day include specific medical care routines, daily living activities, orientation, facility mobility, and/or behavioral control due to moderate physical, cognitive, and/or behavioral challenges.

Our Home & Community-Based Services provide routine care coordination for residents living in a Hope Network apartment or in their own home with varied levels of support, ranging from 24-hour support to daily periodic checks, depending upon the resident's needs.
