OUR REHAB SOLUTIONS ARE WHAT SET US APART.

SUPERVISION REDUCTION

Interdisciplinary collaboration, with a focus on reducing the amount and type of care required by the patient with a brain injury, allowing discharge to a targeted placement or placement level.

PATIENT PROFILE:

Individuals who have suffered a stroke, or are in need of emancipation or general rehabilitation, who may be presenting with the following symptoms:

- Wandering/elopement
- Risk of falls
- Confusion
- Unawareness
- Severe loss of emotional control

PSYCHIATRIC STABILIZATION

Short-term residential neurobehavioral-focused therapy that aims to stabilize a patient's psychiatric functioning allowing them to return to their prior level of care.

PATIENT PROFILE:

For medically stable patients diagnosed with a neurological condition but also exhibiting psychiatric or behavioral symptoms. Through specialized strategies and adaptations, individuals will have the opportunity to overcome difficult cognitive deficits and continue their rehabilitation journey towards functional independence. Patients who would benefit from this Rehab Solution may have the following:

- Functional Neurological Symptom Disorder (FNSD)/Conversion Disorder
- Diagnosis of Reversible Dementia, such as auto-immune encephalitis, carbon monoxide poisoning, heavy-metal poisoning, among others
- Neurological diagnosis with a psychiatric presentation
- Combination of psychiatric and/or medical medications contributing to psychiatric presentation and requires medication review
- Psychiatric condition which requires emergent stabilization



COMPLEX MEDICAL

Interdisciplinary, focused, and intense therapy solutions that concentrate on improving and restoring the functional capacity of an individual who has complex medical issues as well as a neurological condition.

PATIENT PROFILE:

An individual who experiences complex medical complications after suffering a significant neurological event may require additional care and therapy to return home safely. Conditions or diagnoses that fit this profile include:

- Brain Injury Responsiveness (identified as being in the Minimally Conscious State (MCS))
- Chronic pain management and opiate reduction
- Limb loss
- Wound care
- Spinal Cord Injury

CARE TRANSITIONS

Solutions focused on health stability and risk management when transitioning individuals with high care needs to their next level of care. The primary goal is to educate and engage caregivers on general caregiving and injury-specific topics to ensure a smooth discharge transition no matter the placement.

PATIENT PROFILE:

Patients with complex and high-care needs will benefit from additional intensive training provided to the family or designated non-professional caregiver. While training is already integrated into the established Hope Network Neuro Rehabilitation therapy programs, in this case the caregiver training and qualifications are the primary focus.
