

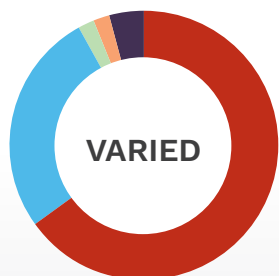


Don't let distance get between your patient and the right level of care.

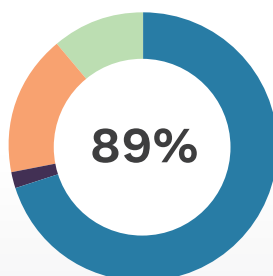
Transitional Rehabilitation Outcomes FY 2024

DIAGNOSIS SERVED



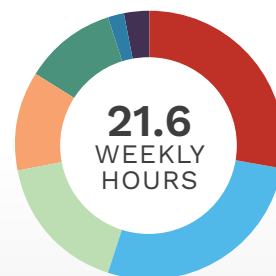
- 65%: Acquired Brain Injury - ABI (except stroke)
- 27%: Stroke
- 2%: Other Neurologic Condition
- 2%: Spinal Cord Dysfunction
- 4%: Ortho Trauma / Multiple Trauma

DISCHARGED TO COMMUNITY



- 70%: Home with family
- 2%: Home alone
- 17%: Supported Living (AFC or AL)
- 11%: Skilled nursing facility

AVERAGE THERAPY PER WEEK



- 28% / 6.0 hrs: Occupational Therapy
- 27% / 5.9 hrs: Physical Therapy
- 17% / 3.6 hrs: Speech & Language
- 12% / 2.6 hrs: Therapeutic Recreation
- 11% / 2.4 hrs: Behavioral Health
- 2% / .4 hrs: Physician Services
- 3% / .7 hrs: Other Services

AVERAGE LENGTH OF STAY: 51 DAYS
