

Home & Community Based Services (H&C)

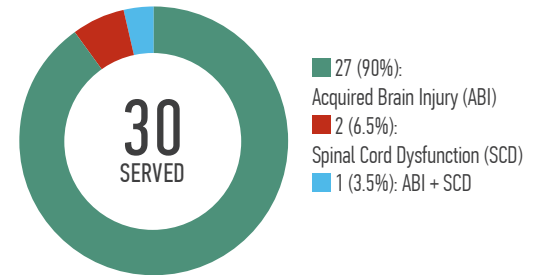
Individuals living with a brain or spinal cord injury, or other neurologic impairments may need some support to help them live as independently as possible, whether in their own home or in a community setting. Hope Network Neuro Rehabilitation (HNNR) offers programs for both settings, depending upon the level of support needed. Individuals receive a customized plan of care, directed by a team of interdisciplinary clinicians and their physician.

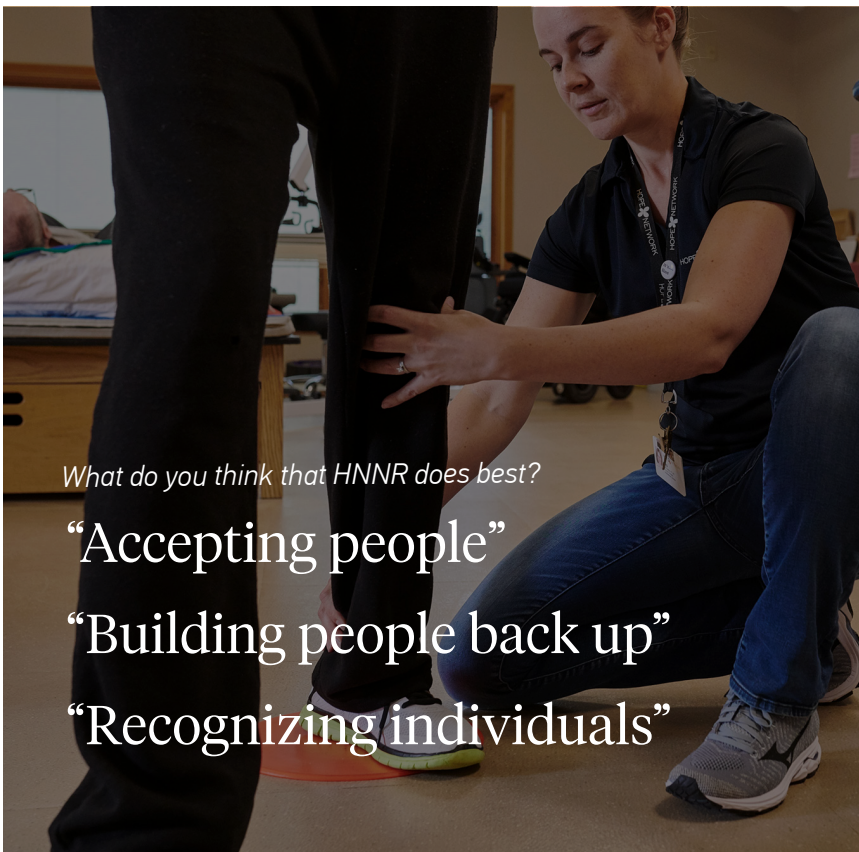

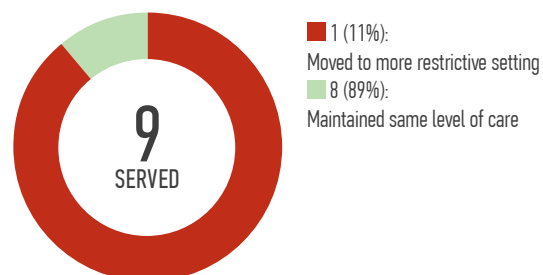

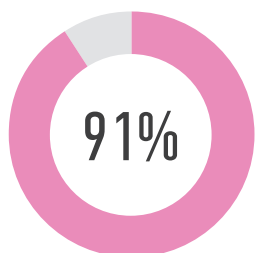

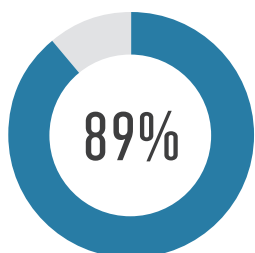

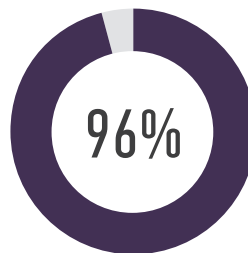
Persons served are satisfied with services provided by HNNR



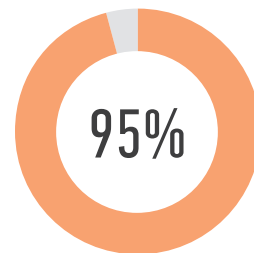
Persons served are happy with their involvement in decision making
