Individuals living with brain or spinal cord injuries or other neurological conditions may need support to help them live as independently as possible, whether in their own home or in a community setting. Routine care coordination is tailored to each individual, with support ranging from daily periodic checks to 24-hour assistance based on their needs.

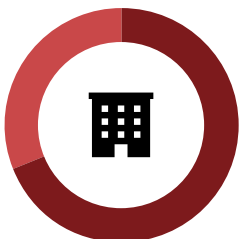

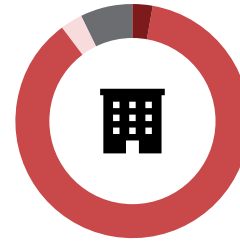
APARTMENT PROGRAM Diagnosis

- Spinal Cord Dysfunction: 31%



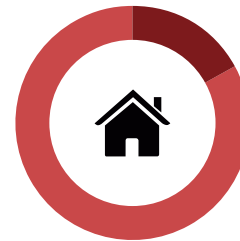
HOPE AT HOME Diagnosis

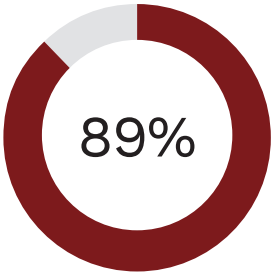
More than 150 team members have completed the Academy of Certified Brain Injury Specialists (ACBIS) training through the Brain Injury Association of America.



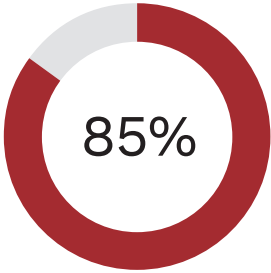

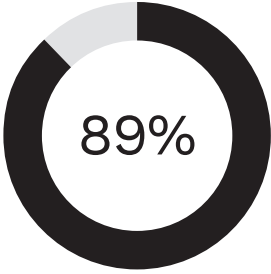

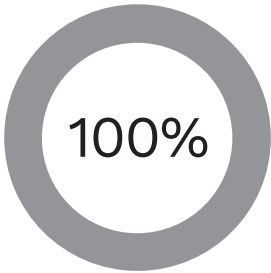
