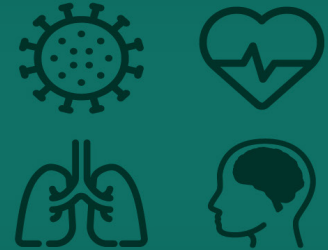


POST-COVID REHABILITATION



Patients discharging from acute care following a SARS-CoV-2 infection, or who have experienced new, recurring, or ongoing symptoms weeks after a SARS-CoV-2 infection, may need additional specialized rehabilitative care to regain their strength, endurance, and cognitive function.

To serve the rehabilitation and recovery needs of patients needing an appropriate discharge placement from a hospital setting, or those who have lingering COVID-19 symptoms (long-COVID), Hope Network Neuro Rehabilitation developed a Post-COVID Recovery Program.

Post-COVID Rehabilitation services are provided in both a community-based residential setting or through an outpatient Day Rehab environment. Both settings provide comprehensive and customized treatment plans that focus on maximizing functional, real-world skills.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- High-value, interdisciplinary therapy: PT, OT, SLP, Psychology
- Reduces secondary deconditioning
- Reduces hospital re-admissions
- Lessens long-term implications and relapses
- Integrated return to work services

COMPLICATIONS ADDRESSED

- Physical debility due to prolonged hospitalization and/or the result of extended time on a ventilator
- Cognitive deterioration or decline to include delirium, difficulty thinking or concentrating, and memory loss
- Emotional distress, anxiety, or PTSD disorders that interfere with rehabilitation
- Stroke
- Fatigue, malaise, and poor endurance affecting daily function and mobility
