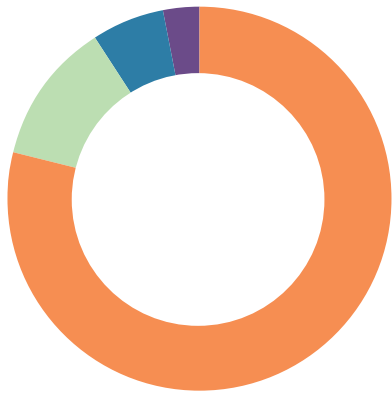


HOME & COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES

APARTMENT PROGRAM: Designed for individuals who require routine assistance in a supported setting to safely and successfully maintain their independence. Residents live in a Hope Network apartment with on-call staff 16-20 hours a day.

PROGRAM STABILITY



- 79%: Maintained Placement
- 12%: Discharged to More Supervision
- 6%: Discharged to Same Level of Supervision
- 3%: Discharged to Independent Living

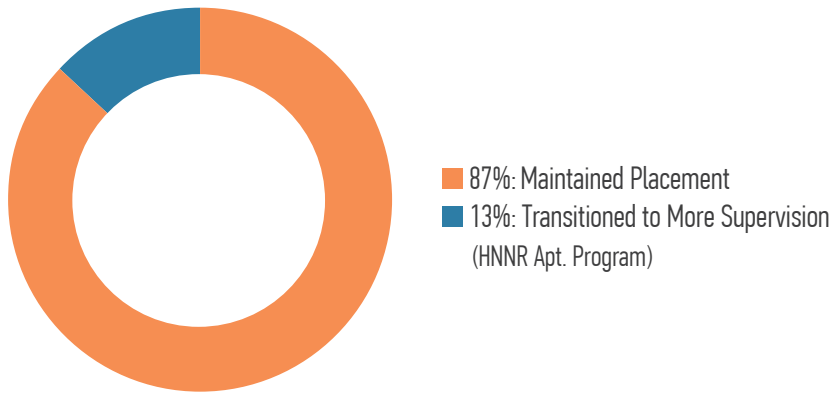

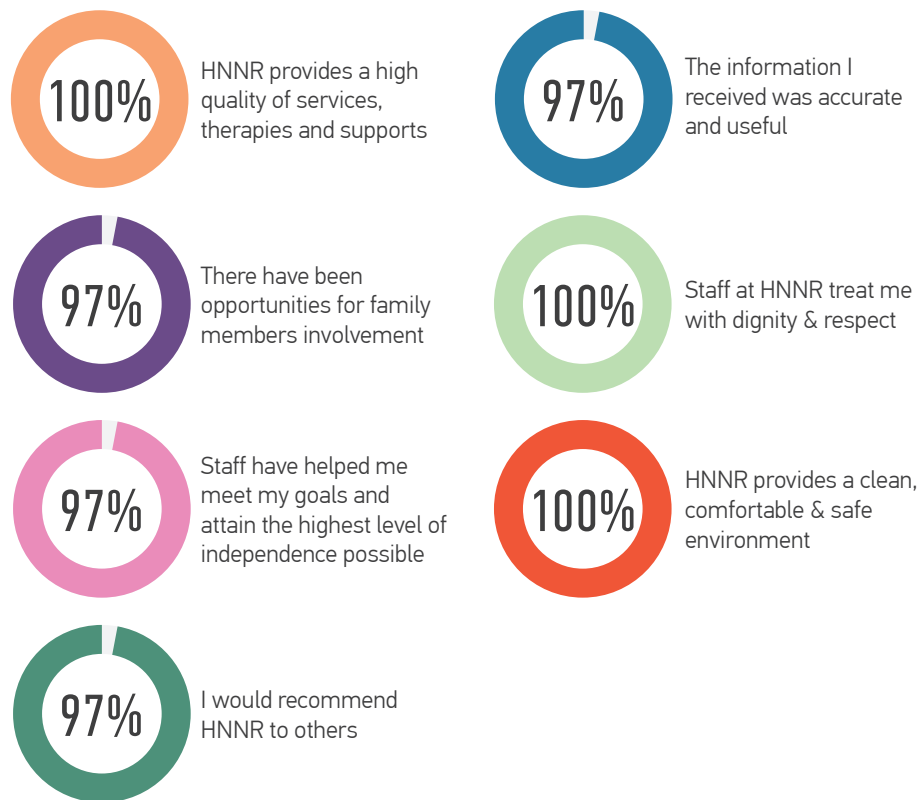

HOPE AT HOME: Designed for individuals living in their own home that may need periodic support to help them to live in a safe and healthy environment. Support is provided as needed, up to 2-4 hours a day.
