TRANSITIONAL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Transitional Neuro Rehabilitation addresses a patient's immediate need to develop the skills necessary to allow the re-learning and generalization of functional living skills, develop strategies to overcome physical and cognitive limitations, and re-establish a productive lifestyle in the community.

NEUROBEHAVIORAL PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Our Neurobehavioral Rehabilitation program provides intensive behavioral modification and social competence retraining to individuals who have experienced significant changes in their personality or behavior since the onset of their traumatic brain injury.

TYPICAL ADMISSION PROFILE

- Diagnosed with a brain injury or other neurologic impairment

- Rancho Los Amigos Level of IV or higher (brain injury)
- Requires 24-hour assistance and supervision by specialized rehabilitation team
- Requires need to develop the skills necessary to allow the re-learning and generalization of functional living skills, develop strategies to overcome physical and cognitive limitations, and re-establish a productive lifestyle in the community.
- 16 years of age or older

DAY REHAB

Our Day Rehab program includes clinical rehabilitation in a non-hospital setting to assist patients comprehensively and conveniently, three to five days per week on an outpatient basis. Services are specially designed for patients who have suffered a brain injury, spinal cord injury, stroke, or those with other neurologic or orthopedic injury or illness. This coordinated, interdisciplinary therapy program allows patients to receive the services they need by day, and return home in the evening to what's most meaningful in their lives.
