Our experts provide a range of services, including Cognitive-Behavioral Therapy (CBT), neuropsychology, psychotherapy, and behavioral analysis, among others. Services can be provided in an outpatient setting or in our post-hospital inpatient program, where services are often integrated with the larger, multi-disciplinary rehabilitation team.

POST-CONCUSSION ASSESSMENT & CARE

For patients recovering from concussion and/or other mild-TBI conditions, our psychologists assess factors that influence an individuals care and recovery, and provide treatment — ranging from simple support and education, to care for more persistent symptoms, requiring complex and integrated multi-disclipinary plans and symptom management.

CHRONIC ILLNESS & DISABILITY

Psychotherapy support of emotional and behavioral adjustment to chronic illness, disability, or diagnoses such as spinal cord injury, traumatic brain injury, stroke, limb loss, or other chronic neurological conditions. Mental health conditions such as substance abuse, depression, and anxiety are addressed in an integrated therapeutic treatment plan.

BEHAVIORAL DISTURBANCE IN ACQUIRED DISABILITY

Assessment and integrated treatment plans for those who require support to overcome behaviors such as uncharacteristic aggression, prolonged confusion, or noncompliance with care. The use of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) therapy interventions structured by Board-Certified Behavior Analysts may be helpful for acquiring skills needed to meet patient goals.

NEUROPSYCHOLOGICAL ASSESSMENTS

Performed by our experts, these assessments provide diagnostic clarity and treatment direction for the development of customized patient care plans for individuals who with neurological conditions and/or disability, particularly where mental health and cognitive function may be in question.

VOCATIONAL INTEGRATION
